VPFAA Recommended Definitions of Rank-Appropriate Faculty Eligible to Vote on Tenure-Line and Non-Tenure-Line Faculty Promotions

Recommended Principles:

- In order to vote, the voting faculty member must be in an appointment category that includes all areas of responsibility (i.e. teaching, research and/or service) for which the faculty member will be evaluated.
- The voting faculty member must have been promoted to the level being sought or the comparable level in their appointment category.
- Faculty on a probationary appointment cannot be rank-appropriate regardless of their title
- Deans may develop alternative principles, but the same definition of who is rank-appropriate should be used for the entire school or college.
